English

This term we will read 'Me and My Fear' by Francesca Sanna. This beautifully illustrated book will allow us to explore emotions, behaviours and perceptions of the world around us. While working with the story, we will also focus on spelling common words, grammar and punctuation, such as capital letters, full stops and commas. We will join handwriting.

Science

Our Science topic this half term will be 'Animals including Humans' Firstly, we will look at food and nutrition, where we will learn about different food groups and nutrients. We will look at food labels create balanced recipes. Next we will focus on the skeleton, learning all about our bones and their functions.



Mathematics

We will begin with an introduction to understanding number and place value with up to 3 digits. We will read and write numbers as numerals and words up to 100 and use place value to partition numbers to 999. We will be ordering numbers and using a blank number line. We will be learning to count in 3s and 4s. We will be building on our year 2 knowledge of addition and subtraction. We will begin using place value and column method to add and subtract using formal and informal methods.

We will discuss positive and negative mental health. We will understand what they can do if they or others are experiencing mental health problems including cyber bullying. We will also discuss how diet, sleep and exercise can lead to positive wellbeing
