Personal and Social Development

This half term we will continue to develop positive relationships with our peers. We will continue to develop our sharing and turn taking skills, developing respectful relationships. We will start to explore our own feelings as well as think about the feelings of others and how our actions may influence the feelings of others. The children will develop independent self help skills, including

Physical Development

We will continue to develop throwing and catching skills when working with a range of equipment. We will learn how to throw and catch with a partner and how to aim at a target.

Children will use small tools such as scissors and paintbrushes appropriately and safely when creating a variety of wonderful pieces of creative artwork. Children will also develop the appropriate grip when using a pencil for writing and drawing and will begin to show accurate formation of a range of letters and numerals.

Communication and Language

Children will learn new vocabulary linked to our topics and they will use it in discussion with their peers and adults. Children will learn a range of songs, stories and poems and they will be able to retell, recite and sing these by heart! We will read a wide variety of a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, showing interest in our class books. We will learn how to ask some basic questions

Mathematics

Children will explore how to write numbers to 10. Children will also match the numeral to a set of objects. Children will learn to subitise—they will learn to state the number of objects there are without counting them individually. Children will also practise counting beyond 20. We will begin to recognise shapes and learn the names of shapes. We will explore patterns made up of colours and shapes and will learn how to copy and continue
