## English

In English, we will read 'The Great Fire of London' by Emma Adams and James Western Lewis. We will learn how to use commas to separate words in a list and how to change adjectives into adverbs by adding 'ly'. We will also learn to use co-ordination by using the words 'but' and 'or'. our learning

## Science

In Science, we will continue to explore different materials and will learn how to distinguish between the object and the material it is made from. We will also learn how to describe the properties of different materials. We will have the opportunity to explore and observe different materials in and around the school grounds.



## Mathematics

In Autumn 2, the children will be focusing on multiplication and division. They will be able to use the symbols for multiplication, division and equals. They will continue their of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. They will use materials, arrays and mental methods to work out their answers. As well, they will focus on fractions. By Christmas, they will be able to name and write fractions:  $1/3$ ,  $1/4$ ,  $2/4$  and  $3/4$ .

## Music

In Music, the children will be learning the unit of work: Tony Chestnut. They will focus on the beat, rhythm, melody, echo, call and response and tuned and untuned instruments. The children will learn the song and actions!
