Personal and Social Development

We will explore following class rules, and understanding why they are important. We will play a range of games that involve taking turns and with adult support we will begin to deal with emotions that are involved with waiting, sharing and turn taking, as well as understanding we can't win all the time and that is ok. We will explore working together to carry out a job such as; help to tidy a shared area.

Physical Development

We will explore taking part in some group activities and develop our ball skills showing control in throwing and catching. We will practise hopping on the spot and travelling. We will use one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors.

Communication and Language

We will develop our communication and language skills by exploring different vocabulary linked to Winter, forces and 'People Who Help Us'. We will use talk to organise our play; "Let's go on a bus... you sit there... I'll be the driver." We will have lots of opportunities for talk in our play, as well as adult lead role play where we can listen to a wide vocabulary and be supported to use it in our role play scenarios.

Nursery People who help us and What to wear in Winter?

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore a range of materials to create different effects and for a purpose. We will create large circles to make 'People Who Help Us' and snowmen. We will practise our singing through a range of songs. We will use props appropriately to recreate a wider range of simple role plays such as vets, restaurant and pretending to drive vehicles.

Mathematics

We will continue exploring numbers. We will demonstrate showing amounts using objects and on our fingers. We will explore recognising digits to 5. We will practise subitising to 3. We will explore 2D shapes and using them to make new shapes. We will explore 3D shapes and match them to 2D shapes. We will develop our positional language and use it to describe where an object has been placed.

Understanding the World

We will explore a range of occupations through role play and books. We will explore what 'People Who Help' us wear and why and how this has changed. We will talk about different forces we can feel such as pushes and pulls. We will explore winter and compare this to autumn. We will explore the different clothes we wear in different types of weather and countries around the world.

Literacy

When exploring texts linked to Winter and the emergency services we will explore the names of the different parts of a book. We will start our reading journey and be introduced to the pictures from RWI and begin to develop listening skills by clapping syllables in a word. We will explore books independently noting items of interest along the way.
