English

In English we are reading 'My name is not Refugee' by Kate Milner. We will write a recount of events from the text from the character's point of view. To do this, we will use the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense, use subordination including because, when and so that, and use punctuation correctly by using apostrophes for the possessive.

Science

We will continue to explore the topic animals including humans this term. We will learn about what animals need to survive. We will use our scientific knowledge in a number of ways including identifying and classifying animals in groups and gathering and recording data.



Mathematics

In Maths, the units of work we will be learning are: Time, Length & Mass and Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. (Number) In our Time lessons, the children will be learning to tell and write the time to five minutes to, including quarter past and quarter to. In our Length & Mass lessons, the children will be able to estimate and measure different units. In our Number lessons, the children will revisit previous learning.

Music

In Music, our unit of work is 'Minibeasts'. The children will compose an accompaniment using tuned percussion, playing chords and creating sound effects. They will also sing clearly articulated words, smoothly and together in time. They will listen to the music and create 'minibeast' inspired dance.

Computing

In Computing, our unit of work is 'Keep safe and create'. In this unit, the children will understand the importance of being safe, responsible and respectful online. They will learn the "Pause & Think Online" song to remember basic digital citizenship concepts.



DT

In DT, our unit of work is 'Vehicles'. The children will research, design and then create their own moving vehicles. They will learn what chassis and axles mean.

In RE, our unit of work is 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?' The children will be learning about Christianity, Easter, resurrection and Good Friday.

Geography

In Geography, our unit of work is 'Why is our world wonderful?' The children will identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map, as well as identifying human and physical features. In addition, they will name and locate the five oceans on a world map. They will use an aerial photograph to draw a simple sketch map and then collect data after completing fieldwork.
