English

In English, we will be reading *Beegu* by Alexis Deacon. The children will continue to use joining words as well as punctuating sentences using a capital letter, full stop and a question mark. They will also add suffixes to words. The writing outcome for this unit is for the children to write their own version of the story with a new lost creature.

Science

In Science we will explore the topic animals including humans this term. We will learn about what features different types of animals have and what different animals eat. We will use our scientific knowledge in a number of ways including identifying and classifying animals in groups and gathering and recording data.



Mathematics

In Maths, the units of work we will be learning are: **Multiplication and Division, Addition and Subtraction, and Time**. In our Multiplication lessons children will learn to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will also be exploring doubling and halving facts up to 50. In our Addition and subtraction lessons children will be revisiting and building on previous knowledge. In our time lessons the children will be learning to tell and write the time to the hour and half past.

Music

In Music, our unit of work is 'Football'. The children will explore echo singing, composing word patterns, improvising with mi-re-do, and playing a percussion instrument. Activities will support pupils to understand the difference between pitched patterns and rhythm patterns.

Computing

In Computing, our unit of work is 'programming direction'. The unit focuses on directional instructions and creating sequences using a number of programs and equipment. The children will continue to create algorithms and understand how to debug if something goes wrong with their program.



DT

In DT, our unit of work is 'Moving Minibeasts'. The children will research, design and then create their own moving pictures using sliders, levers and pivots to create mechanisms.

Our PE days will be on a Tuesday and a Thursday.

The units of work we will be doing are:

ABC and Attacking and Defending

RE

In RE, our unit of work is 'What is the Easter Story and can you order the events?' The children will be learning about Christianity, Easter, resurrection and Good Friday.



Geography

In Geography, our unit of work is 'What is the weather like in the UK?' They will learn to identify and locate the four UK countries, recognise their own country and describe locations using basic compass directions. They also measure different types of weather, describe seasonal changes and suggest appropriate clothing and activities for each season.
