English

In English we are reading 'Tidy' by Emily Gravett. We will learn to use apostrophes in contracted forms. We will add 'er' and 'est' to adjectives and use subordination 'if' and 'that'. We will learn to use homophones and near homophones before finally writing a persuasive letter in role.

Science

In Science, we are learning about plants, seeds and bulbs. We will enhance our knowledge of what plants need in order to survive. We will learn that germination means when a seed, bulb or bean grows into a plant. Finally, we will conduct our own experiments to find out what plants need to survive and grow.



Mathematics

In Maths, the children will enhance their knowledge of Fractions by recognising and finding $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$ and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or a quantity. In addition, they will be exploring practical activities when we learn about capacity and temperature. The children will be able to measure capacity and temperature to the appropriate unit, using thermometers and vessels.

PSHE



The children will explore the unit: Living in the Wider World. They will learn about the topics: rules beyond school their local community, giving their opinion, exploring their needs and also exploring their wants. The unit will give the children a chance to debate and voice their opinions.

Computing

In Computing, the children will Programme with Logo. They will understand what algorithms are, how they are implemented as programs on digital devices, and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions. They will also create and debug simple programs.



Art

In Art, we will use our imagination to play and explore using different materials. We will reinvent the stick and create our own Worry Dolls and a Treehouse. Finally, we will evaluate our work and think about how we could improve our sculptures.
