English

In English, we will read the story 'Look Up' by Nathan Bryon. We will write a diary entry about a space flight, drawing on wider reading about the topic to inform interesting vocabulary choices. We will continue to use correct punctuation including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will learn to use expanded noun phrases building on our knowledge of adjectives.

Science

In Science, we will explore different materials and will learn how to distinguish between the object and the material it is made from. We will also learn how to describe the properties of different materials. We will have the opportunity to explore and observe different materials in and around the school grounds.



Mathematics

In Maths, we will develop our understanding of numbers and place value, working with 2-digit numbers. We will find 1 more and 1 less than a number and order numbers on a number line. We will continue to learn how to use comparative symbols to compare numbers. We will work hard to write numbers as figures and words, focusing on accurate spelling. We will secure basic addition and subtraction skills and will learn how to use formal written methods.

Music

We will be learning the song, Tony Chestnut. In this unit, children will be encouraged to sing with good diction to emphasise word play, learn to play the melody of the song on tuned percussion and working by ear, explore call-and-response, making up call-and-response patterns with actions, their voices and with instruments.

Computing

In Computing, we will learn about computer safety. We will recognise the common uses of information and technology. We will learn how to use technology safely and respectfully. We will understand the importance of keeping personal information private and know where to go for help.



Art

In Art, we will explore using natural materials to create different patterns and shapes inside and outside of the classroom. We will refine drawing techniques and be able to explain why we have used those techniques.

RE

In RE, we will explore why Jesus is special and what Christians believe was the 'good news' that he brought. Children will also explore how Christians try to follow Jesus' example by bringing 'good news' to others and how prayer, saying sorry and forgiveness are connected within Christian beliefs.

History

In History, we will learn how school was different in the past. We will begin by ordering photographs on a timeline and add some dates. We will make comparisons between schools in the past and present and use sources to research what school was like 100 years ago. Finally, we will discuss whether we would prefer to go to school in the past or present and explain why.
